

Saint Frances Cabrini MASS DAY Formal DRESS CODE (5132)

BOYS

Tops

- Forest Green, Black, Gray, and White polo, long or short-sleeved
- Saint Frances Cabrini logo is not required
- 1 brand logo is allowed, but smaller than a credit card
- Polos must be tucked in during Mass.

Bottoms

- Khaki or Black slacks
- No sweatpants
- Must sit at the natural waistline

Note: Shorts CANNOT be worn to Mass but a change of shorts can be brought for after. Boys may wear khaki or black shorts before October 15th and after April 15th, after Mass.

GIRLS

Tops

- Forest Green, Black, Gray, and White polo, long- or short-sleeved
- Girls may wear a Forest Green, Black, Gray, or White polo dress (no logo required).
- Saint Frances Cabrini logo is not required
- 1 brand logo is allowed, but smaller than a credit card
- Polos must be tucked in during Mass.

Bottoms

- Khaki or Black slacks
- Must sit at the natural waistline
- Khaki or black skirts or jumpers
- No sweatpants
- Girls may wear solid Forest Green, Gray, White, or Black leggings/tights only with dress code skirts or jumpers. Leggings and tights must be worn under the skirt or jumper between Oct 15th-April 15th
- Hems should be four inches above the knee or longer.

Note: Shorts or Capris CANNOT be worn to Mass but a change of shorts or capris can be brought for after. Girls may wear khaki or black shorts or capris before October 15th and after April 15th, after Mass.

Footwear

- Secure footwear is important for student safety during active learning throughout the school day.
- All shoes must have a closed toe, and a closed-back
- Students may wear athletic shoes or non-athletic shoes.
- Note: Athletic shoes will still be needed for PE classes.
- Socks must be worn with footwear.

Optional Dress Code Items

- Solid Forest Green, Black, Gray or White sweater vests, cardigans, or pullovers may be worn over a dress code approved collared shirt.
- Saint Frances Cabrini logo is not required
- Solid Black, White, Grey, Forest Green turtlenecks
- Belts are recommended and must be plain Brown, Black, or White.
- 1 brand logo is allowed, but smaller than a credit card

General Appearance

- Clothing should be neat, clean, in good repair, and of appropriate size and length. No clothing should show undergarments, lower back, midriff, etc.
- Hair should be clean and worn in an appropriate hairstyle.
- No unnatural colors (ie. pink, blue, green, etc.).
- Excessive make-up is not to be worn.
- Necklaces, bracelets, earrings, and rings may not present a safety hazard or be inappropriate. Earrings are acceptable for girls only.

Where can you purchase dress code items?

- Lands End (NO logo required)
- Target
